- The irrigation system maximizes the efficiency of water, avoiding wastage.
- Valle dell'Acate is committed to the requalification of the surrounding area through the renovations of the cellar, that, without changing its characteristics, bring to light the ancient splendor of the place, its history and beautiful nature.
- The commitment of Valley dell'Acate in the development of the territory and the significant peculiarity of the region, continues with the project: "7 terre per 7 vini" (7 lands for 7 wines) The proper growing site, has been selected for each wine. This will ensure the typical characteristics of the final product. Each wine tells a story: the story of the land where it was born and from which it takes appearance and consistency This indissoluble bond between past, present and future can be found in every sip.

"This award makes us very proud because, knowing that the future of our sector and, first of all, of our planet depends on sustainability, we are investing a great deal on it. Sustainability has as its

basic principle of environmental protection. People like me who makes wine lives every day in contact with nature and the earth, so learn to respect it and take care of it without altering the equilibrium.

With an annual production of about 400,000 bottles, the Valle dell'Acate wines, are successfully exported in the world. In addition to the United States, Europe, and Canada, they have also reached the new Asian markets, from Japan to China, from Russia to India. They are well known in Italy, especially in Sicily.
